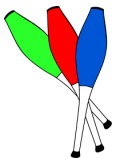

The great thing about juggling is that you can start at any level - there are many simple and wonderful throws and sequences that can be done with only one ball, and eventually add a second, and a third. Alongside working on the 3 ball pattern we will do a lot of 1 ball work that can later be incorporated into 3 ball work.
